

本の英文は、中学生のサトミ(Satomi)が職場体験学習(work experience)について英語の授業で行ったスピーチの一部です。これを読んで、あとの(1)~(3)に答えなさい。*印の語句には、スピーチのあとに(注)があります。(計 21 点)

Last month, I had work experience at a hospital. Ms. Yamada, one of the nurses there, was my *instructor. I was able to learn a lot of things from her.

On the first day, she told me how to *make the beds. I had to do it quickly, but it was quite hard for me. While I was making the beds, Ms. Yamada talked to the *patients in the room. They were talking about the weather, the news, and so on. She said, "I always try to communicate with our patients. I think it's one of the most important ways to find out how they are doing."

On the second day, I looked after an old man. He couldn't eat his meal without help. Ms. Yamada showed me how I should help him, and then I did it alone. I wasn't very good at it, but he thanked me and looked very happy. After that, I told Ms. Yamada about the experience. I said, "I was glad to know he felt happy. I think I'm beginning to understand a little bit about "nursing'."

On the last day, I helped Ms. Yamada look after a patient from Canada. I was nervous because it was my first time to meet a foreigner outside of school. I was also surprised because Ms. Yamada was talking with the patient in English.

Three days after I finished my work experience, I wrote a short thank-you letter to Ms. Yamada. I told her that the experience opened the door to my future and now I know what kind of nurse I want to become.

I am a junior high school student living in Aomori. One day in English class, our school's ALT, Matthew, was telling us about his trip to Okinawa. He asked us, "Have you ever been to Okinawa?" Most of the students answered, "No." He told us that he went to Okinawa and visited many famous tourist sites during the summer holidays. He said that his favorite place was the Okinawa Churaumi Aquarium. It was my first time to hear the name of the aquarium, but it was interesting to listen to his story about the animal exhibitions there.

After school, I decided to do some research about the history of the aquarium. The aquarium first opened in November 2002 and was the largest aquarium in the world at the time. It was also one of the few aquariums which breed large sharks and *rays such as the *whale shark and *manta ray. The aquarium also *participates in many *conservation efforts. It collects data on the *marine life found around Okinawa. This data is used to discover more sustainable ways of using the natural environment while protecting the marine life.

The next day, I talked with Matthew about the information I found. He said, "It's important for us to understand marine conservation. There are many things we can do every day to help with these efforts." "Like what?" I asked him. "Overseas, it is common for restaurants and cafés to use paper straws instead of plastic ones," he answered. Then, I remembered *a time when I went to the convenience store. "In Japan, convenience stores usually ask customers whether they need a plastic bag for their goods. Is this to reduce the *impact plastic bags have on the environment and marine life?" "That's right. An exhibition at Okinawa Churaumi Aquarium also explained that plastic bags were one of the leading reasons for the death of marine turtles. They look like food, so marine turtles eat them. After the turtles die, plastic bags can be found inside their stomachs by scientists."

After this conversation, I realized that I was interested in marine life and its conservation. I want to learn more about marine life and discover new ways of protecting the environment. There are simple things we can do every day to reduce plastic in the ocean. By doing <u>such things</u>, we can help *ensure the future of the ocean and its marine life.
